


## Measuring for Bridle Parts



Use a flexible (material) measuring tape and hold it flat against the horse's head – using the following guide to the nearest half-inch.

### Point A

- Cheekpieces

Measure from just past the eye to the corner of the mouth

- Crownpiece

From one corner of the mouth, measure along one side, around the poll down to the corner of the mouth on the other side

### Point B

- Noseband

About an inch and a half below the cheekbone, measure around the nose where the noseband should lie. It is advisable to measure the headpeace (Point where A and B intersect), around the poll to the same point on the other side of the head.

### Point C

- Throatlatch

At the intersection of Point A and Point D (about the end of the browband) on one side of the horse's head, measure to the same point on the other side going under the throat.

### Point D

- Browband

At the intersection of Point A and Point D (about the end of the browband) on one side of the horse's head, measure to the same point on the other side going across the forehead.
